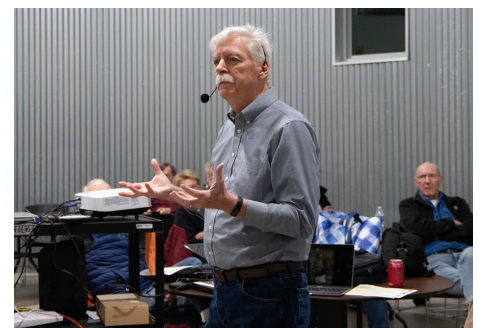
November Meeting Wrapup

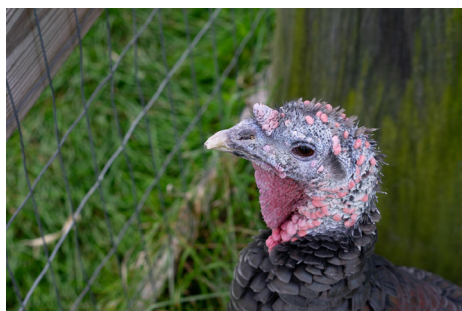
Indiana Dunes. The meeting closed with members sharing Show and Tell photos.



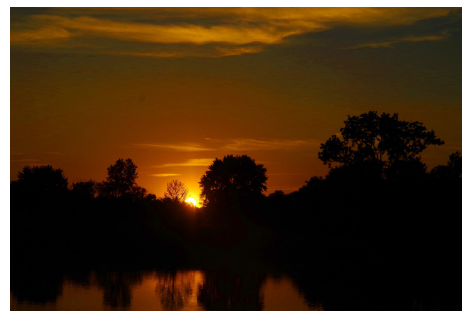

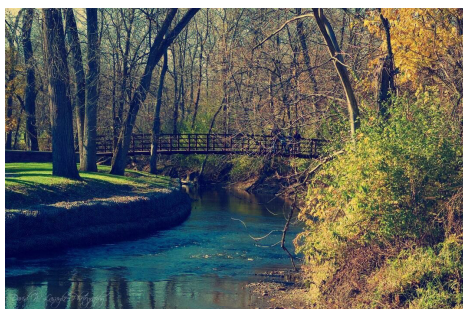
May | Terry Fairchild

In November, the migrating Sandhill Cranes congregate at the Jasper-Pulaski Fish and Wildlife Area. This makes for some great

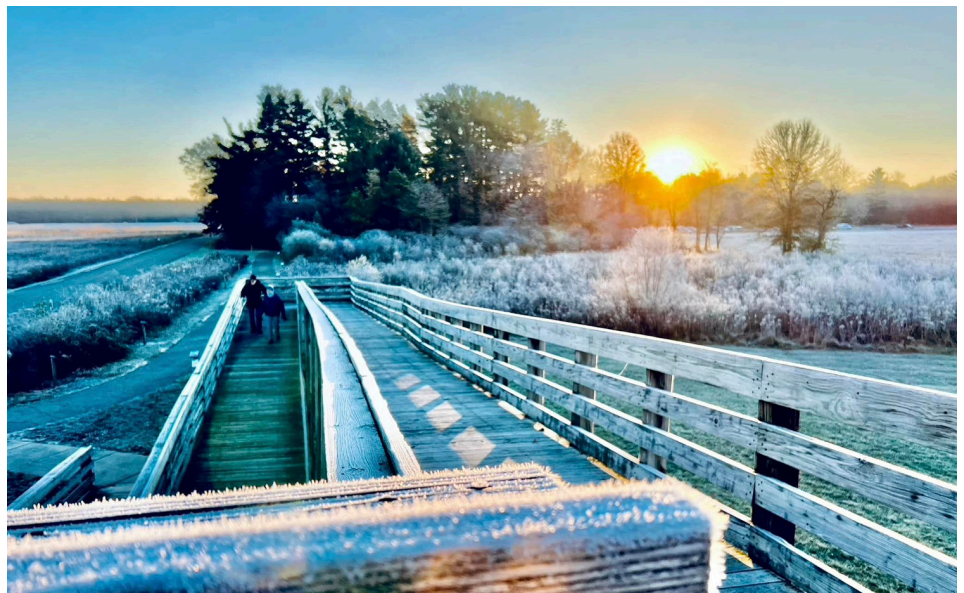
photo opportunities of these majestic birds.

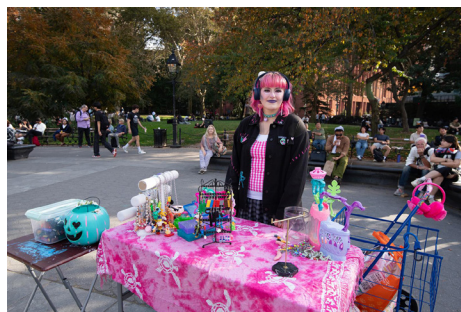
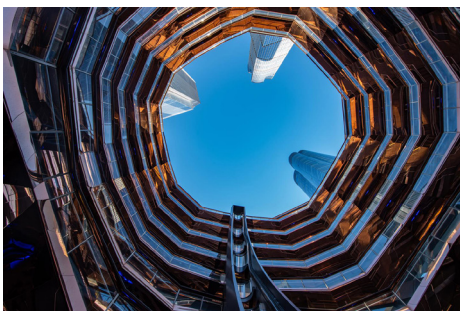
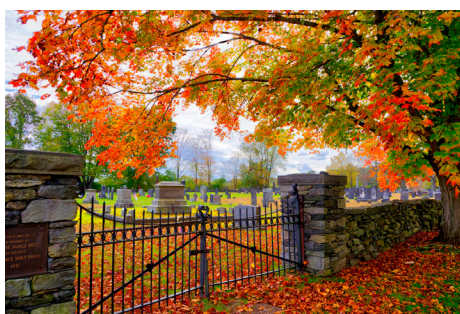


Steve Bensing

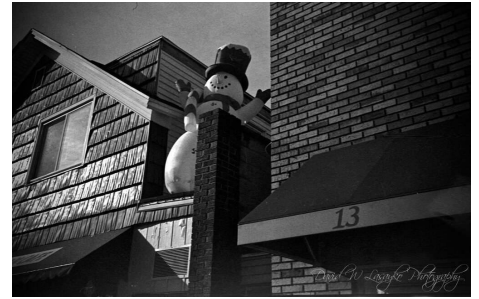

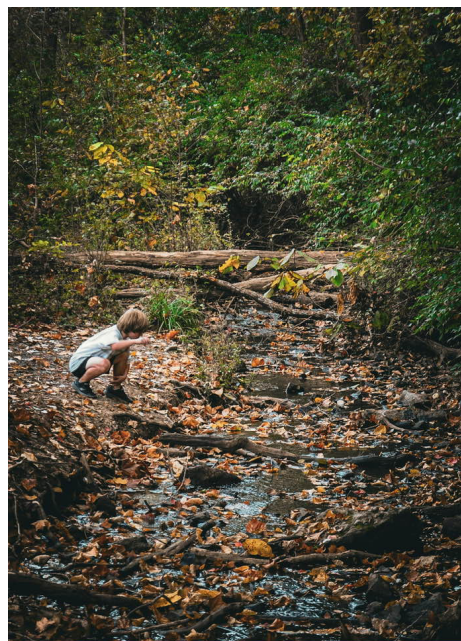

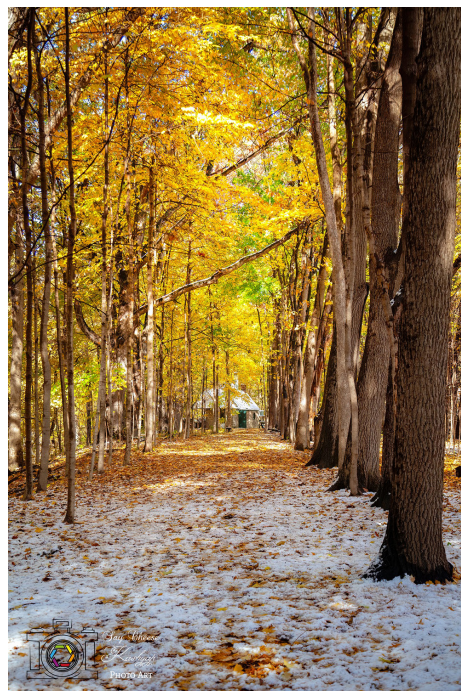
