PRESIDENT'S CORNER



Photography is a wonderful activity that we enjoy. It is magic to see light captured by some type of device to create an image that can be appreciated later. Today, I'd like each of us to consider the purpose(s) of our own photography. Understanding that will help you focus (pun intended) on what is important to you.

One purpose of photography is to document. We can take photos to record family events and places we have been. One area of photography included in this category is

photojournalism. Recent events were the total eclipse or aurora borealis that many of us captured. When we document things, it is important to accurately represent what we see, using good technique, such as focus and exposure. This does not mean we can't be creative. Using good composition makes the photos compelling. I treasure memories I have recorded.

Another purpose of photography is to use it as a creative outlet. The art of photography involves not only using the rules of technique and composition, but stretching and even breaking those rules to express something new. Art includes not only an idea or visualization, but depicting that to viewers in a way that the idea or vision is communicated. This involves not only using a camera, but editing and presenting those images. We may even sell our work or start a business using those skills. If you enjoy showing your work for others to see, your purpose of photography may be in creating art.

For many of us, the joy of doing photography is our purpose. The activity of going somewhere to find an interesting subject and exploring ways to see and photograph it is what we like. We may enjoy learning something new and mastering a craft. We may do this as an individual activity, but we may also get together

The May meeting of the Duneland Photography Club was moved to the Program Center due to the Elections Board using the Horton Family Education Center for the Indian Primary Election. 32 members and visitors enjoyed the cozy space of our old meeting room. Mari Patis, Programs Coordinator of the Shirley Heinze Land Trust gave a presentation on the Places and Opportunities for Photographers in the Shirley Heinze properties.

The mission of Shirley Heinze Land Trust is to preserve and restore natural lands and waters in northwestern Indiana, and to engage people in nature and conservation. With over 3,000 acres protected across 6 different counties, Shirley Heinze Land Trust is dedicated to preserving a variety of habitats, from prairie,

dune and swale, black oak savanna, moraine forest, wetlands, and bogs. The trust engages communities through a variety of programs, hikes, environmental education, agricultural land protection program, water quality monitoring, and volunteer workdays.

As the Programs Coordinator, Mari Patis plans events that range from art-based nature programs, seasonal hikes, nighttime mothing, and forest bathing. A native of the Pacific Northwest, Mari has immersed herself in the diversity of habitats, flora, and fauna of the duneland region. She also enjoys taking photos with her 35mm film camera and spending time with her cat, Kinoko.






