



Photography was a part of my life from an early age; I got my first camera at age 5. Later, my grandpa let me use his 35mm Leica as I started taking classes in high school.

I have learned much from our meetings, classes, and activities. I met people like Jim Conrad, Deb Armstrong, Norman Turner, Jim Rettker, Dan Ruggaber, Victor Grimes, Donna Lind, Gordan Wilder, John Giolas, Robert Evans,

Brady Williams, Sharon Kerner, LeAnn Angerman, and many others (too many to list) who have taught me and given me many ideas over the years. (Sadly, Jim C., Victor, John G., Brady and others are now gone, but their influence lives on). I appreciate many more who have joined us over the years. You have given presentations, led activities, shown your work, shared ideas on Facebook and volunteered. Your influence lives on in me. I am also encouraged by the enthusiasm and participation of our newer members who continue to make this fun. I learn something from each of you.

Steve had his photo from downtown Chesterton, "Fall Gazebo" chosen as the center photo of the newly created Chesterton-opoly Game.


It is being sold at the Duneland Chamber of Commerce and other Chesterton Businesses.

TERRY FAIRCHILD


